Your medical equipment, the tools of your trade, is a critical and expensive purchase. The instruments you buy will serve you for many years to come. For the 2017 academic year, we will be working with John Pancratz from The Medical Store. 4. For FREE shipping back to school select “Delivery to School” as your shipping method. **YOU MUST ORDER BY 8/3/17**. Orders will be delivered for free to school by 8/21/17.
