Anatomy Laboratory safety issues listed below and agree to abide by them.

1. Location of exits and procedures for evacuation during fire alarms.
2. Location of first aid kits & eye wash station.
3. Chemicals used, and safety issues regarding chemicals in the anatomy laboratory;
Location of the MSDS.
4. Proper procedure for spills and clean up.
5. Requirement for wearing gloves and scrubs in the anatomy laboratory.
6. Requirement for wearing closed-toed, closed-top shoes in the anatomy laboratory.
7. Requirement for wearing eye protection when necessary.
8. Lipstick or lip balm is not to be worn in the laboratory. **Caution** should be used if wearing (or intending to wear) soft contact lenses – if you have any doubt, check with your optometrist or ophthalmologist first.
9. Eating, drinking and smoking are not allowed in the anatomy laboratory.
10. Proper procedure for disposing of **anatomical** remains & location of anatomical waste containers;
Disposal of **non-anatomical** waste & location of trash receptacles.
11. Under no circumstance is **any** anatomical material to leave the anatomy lab. Unauthorized removal of anatomical material from the anatomy laboratory is a criminal offense.
12. Cell phones are not allowed to be used in the anatomy lab. Ringers should be turned off, or set to vibrate.
13. Photographs / pictures are not allowed, at any time, without prior approval by either Dr. Andruess, Dr. Hisley, Dr. Eliot or Mr. Silverman **only**.
14. Anatomy lab hours, combination to front door, guests, misc.
15. Proper procedure for adjusting cadaver table height.
16. Proper procedure for installing, removing, and disposing of scalpel blades.
